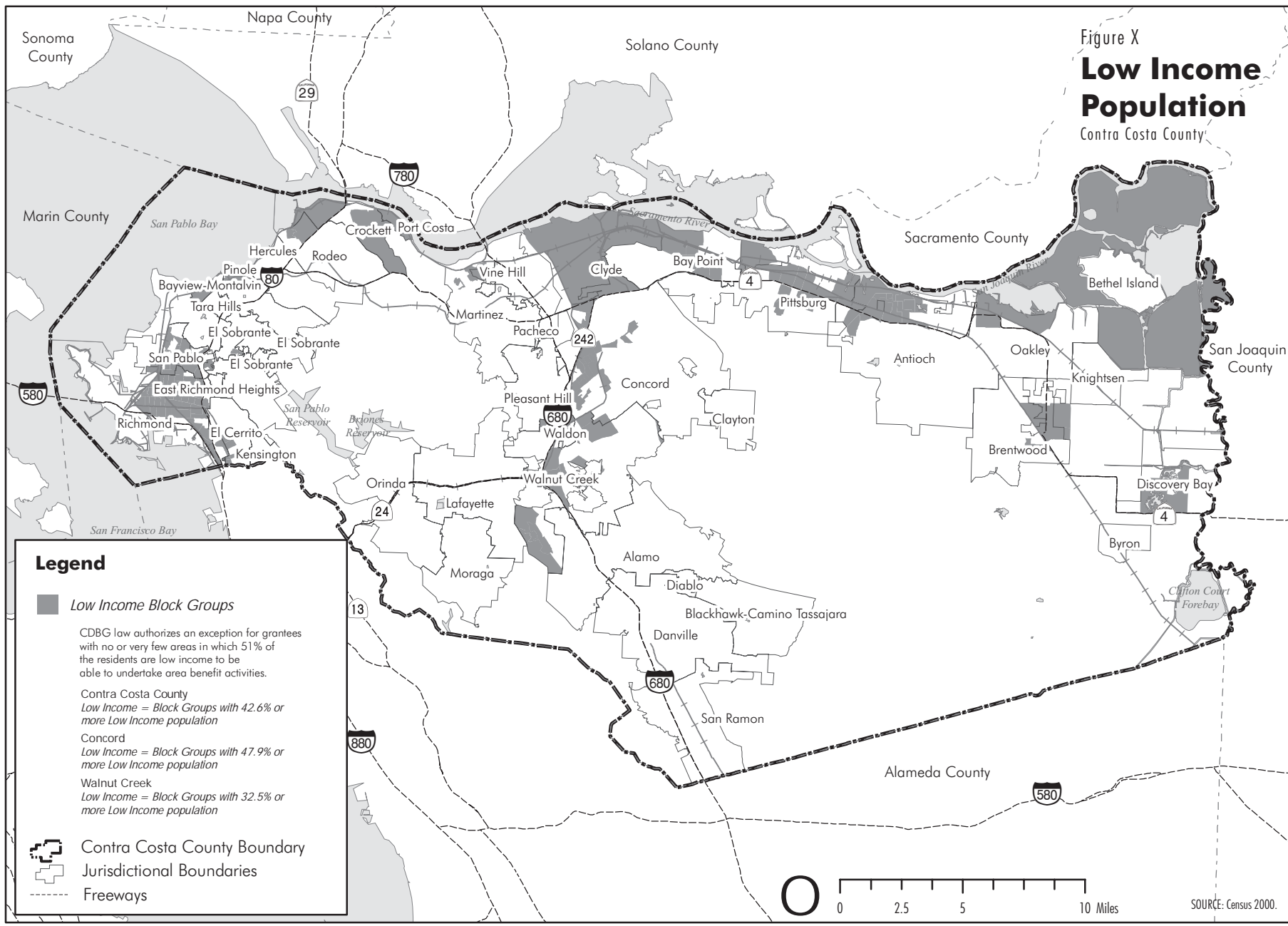

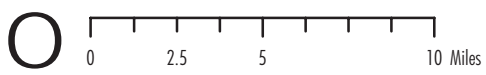

 Contra Costa County



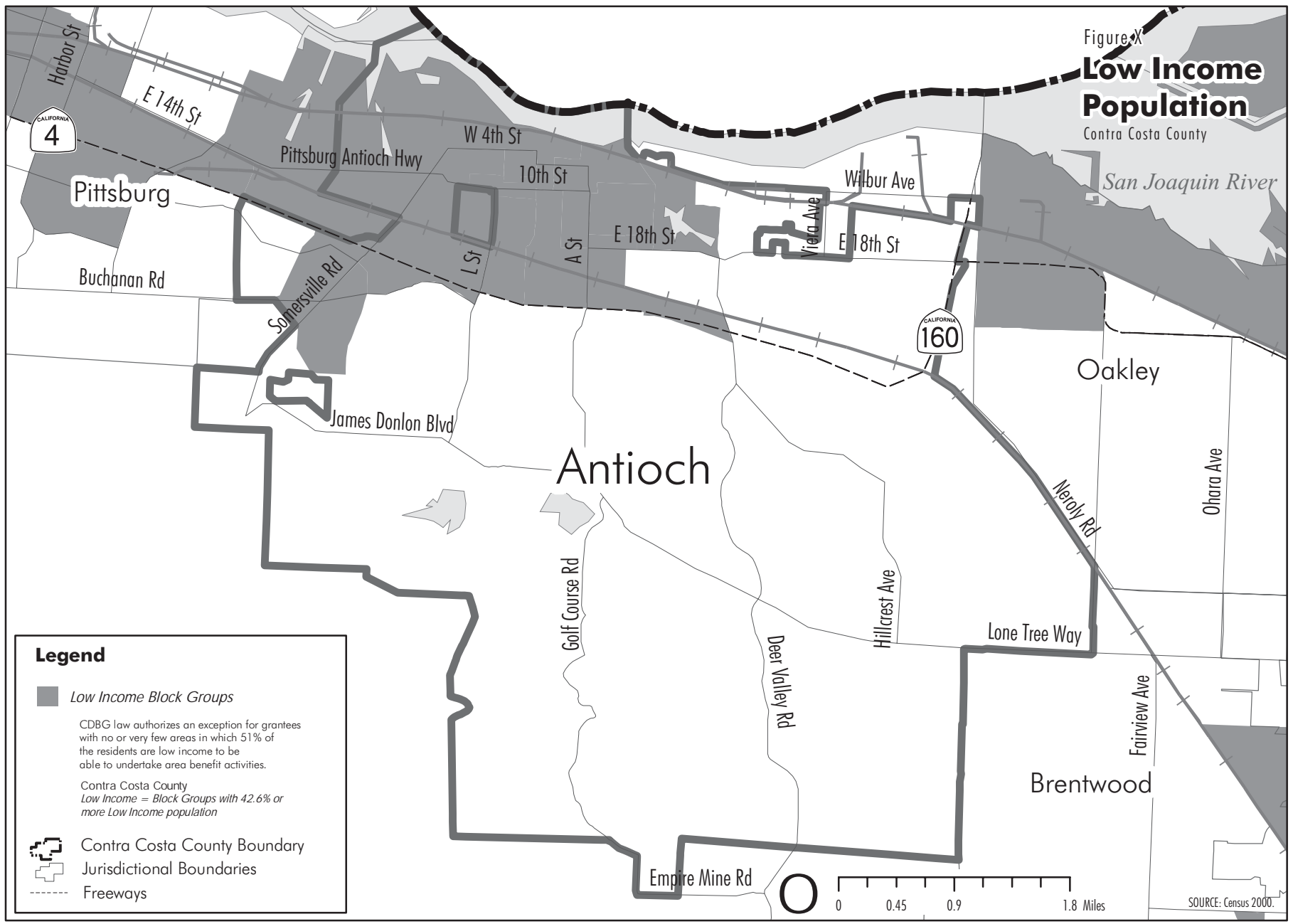

 Contra Costa County

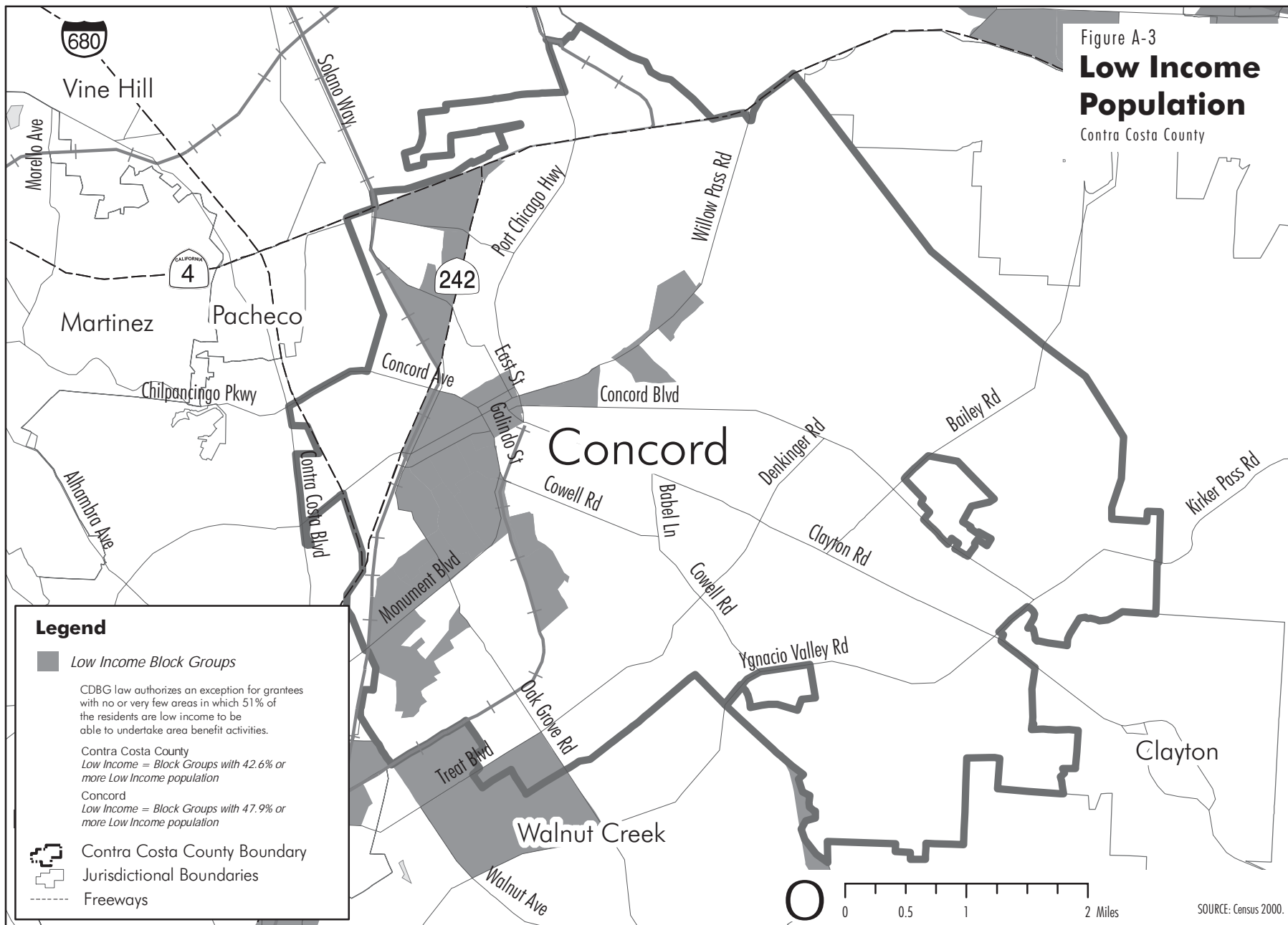
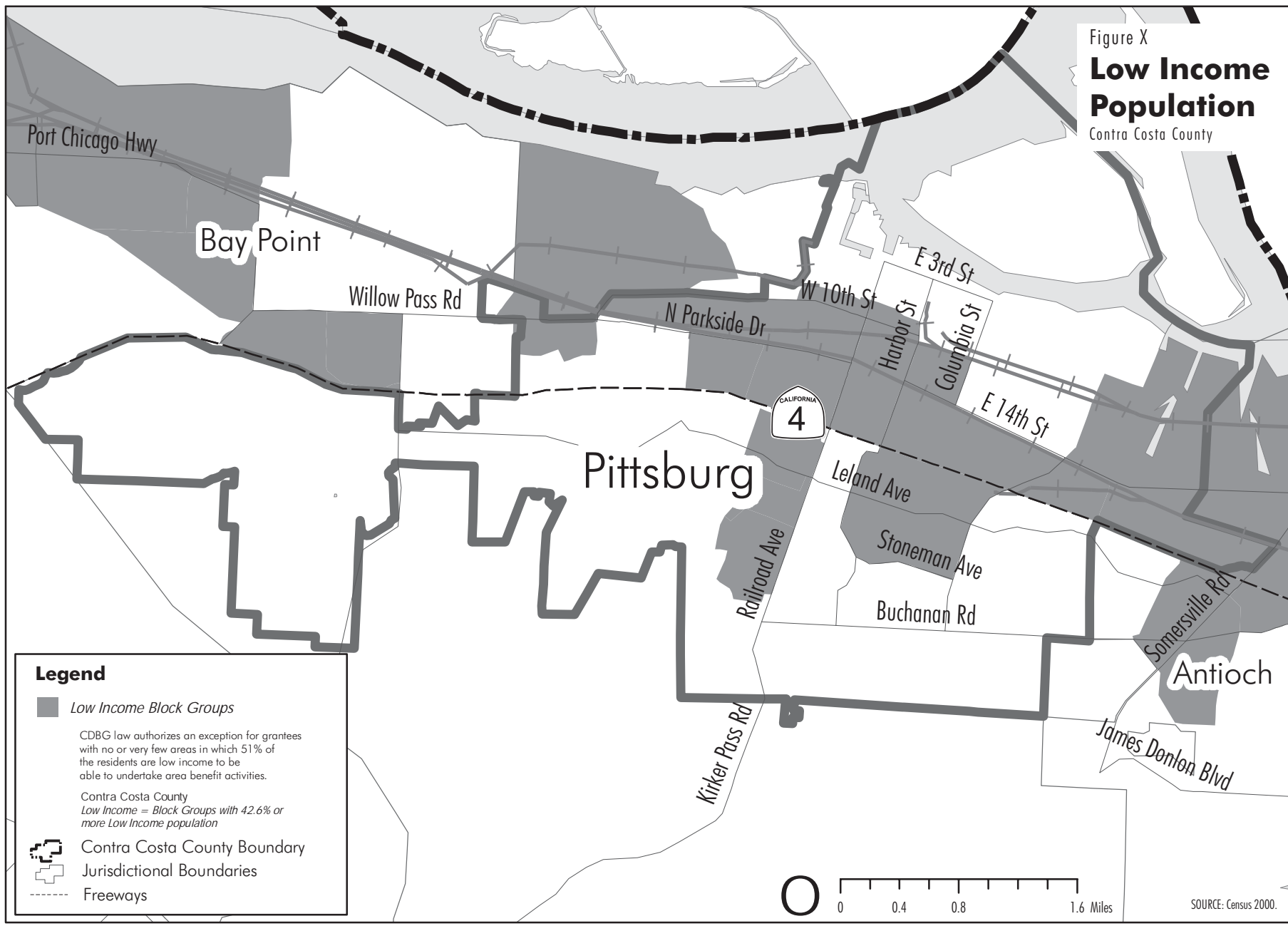




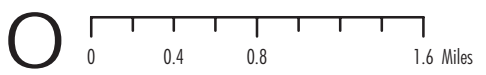
